1976 -273 primary students enrolled and enrolments continued to climb.

1977 P & C donation cards re-introduced to raise funds.

Canteen was renovated.

Windows in school replaced with aluminium.

The cottages in Cameron Street were purchased by Department of Education.

There were 3 kindergarten classes with 36, 37 and 36 children in them.

The wooden climbing equipment was installed.

1976 Introduction of Maths and reading text books was discussed. Fencing of the vacant block commenced.





1989 A school cookbook

Year 3 and Year 6 sat the

The end of Byrnes St at
Percival St was closed

1985 Oval was used by community after school and on weekends.

1981 The new four term years commenced.
The school was 60% ethnic with a large Macedonian and Greek population.
New sports uniform was introduced

1978 Parking problems around the school.
Canteen helpers needed.
Canteen became a sub commitee of the P & C.

1988 Carlton celebrated Australia's bicentennial with a great parade and a ceremony where two native Australian trees were planted beside the flagpole. Mr Charles Williams, the oldest ex-student (pictured - who attended between 1920-1934) was given the honour of planting a tree.

1979 Some demountable classrooms arrived for the school. Class size reduced to 31.

180 trees are now planted around the new grass area. Summer uniform is to be changed.

1980 Ceiling fans were installed in classrooms.

Mr Ron Rathbone, ex student and

Mayor of Rockdale is the new Patron of the School.

A demonstration of the use of a computer was held.
