CARLTON PUBLIC SCHOOL BAND

INFORMATION FOR PROSPECTIVE BAND MEMBERS AND PARENTS

Welcome to our School Band Program.

The children of Carlton are provided with opportunities to experience the rewards of Band membership. Participation in Band provides not only the acquisition of instrumental skills, but the wonderful experience of co-operative music making and the confidence of shared performance. In fact, as research continues to show, the benefits gained from participation in a Band program greatly exceed those intrinsic to the discipline of music alone, with participants displaying increased self-esteem, self-discipline, individual and group management skills and team spirit. The program also provides the children with a positive focus and a worthwhile pursuit as members of our society.

The Band Program, which requires a **minimum of one full year's continued commitment**, is structured as follows:

- Performing Band Rehearsals in the school hall at 7:30am -8:30am on Tuesday morning followed by our Training Band from 8:30-9:15am.
- Weekly small group sectional tutorials for 30 minutes after school on Monday. (Between 3:15-4:15)

HOW TO JOIN THE BAND

Extensive research has shown that for a student to have the best chance of success, they need to be enthusiastic about their instrument choice. While there are certain physical limitations for some instruments (arm length for trombone, finger span for saxophone, etc.), the key factor to being successful when learning an instrument is commitment to practice, and for that to happen they need to **want** to play what is in their hands.

Mr Robinson held an information session for the students demonstrating various band instruments so they will have a bit of an idea of what is involved. The next step is for them to familiarise themselves more at home. We have set up a website, linked below, where you can all access some great examples of the band instruments offered. Sometimes there are misconceptions or a lack of understanding of some of the less common instruments available which this should make a bit clearer. Please take some time to go through these links with your child to get an idea of what they might like to play.

Accompanying this information letter will be a Band Application, which will include a section on instrument preferences. The students will be asked to list their 3 favourite instruments from what they have seen and listened to, as well as a short sentence or two to express what they liked about each. There is also a section to describe past musical experience and current instrumental learning if any.

Please note that you do not need to already play an instrument to join the band. In training band, we will always start at step 1 and learn everything needed together.

Following the return of applications, Mr Robinson will meet with the students to discuss their participation and make a final instrument selection. If they already play an instrument they will be asked to bring it along. If they already play an instrument but would like to learn something new that is also totally okay.

Please complete the Band Application and return it to Mr Omar by **Thursday 18 February**.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

- Submit your application to be considered for a position in the 2021 CPS Training Band.
- Upon being offered a place, return the acceptance, along with the signed Contract of Commitment.
- Students will receive their instruments and equipment in our band start-up session (date TBA).
- Weekly full band rehearsals will be held on Tuesday mornings. Performing Band in the school hall at 7:30am -8:30am on Tuesday morning followed by our Training Band from 8:30-9:15am.
- Weekly small group sectional tutorials will be held for 30 minutes after school on Mondays.
- To assist with home practice the students are all given access to 'Essential Elements Online'. This offers many resources such as a recording studio and practice log. There is also a parent portal access so you can keep up with what they are learning and ask any questions you may have.
- There will be regular tasks set using the online portal to keep track of student progress.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF BAND MEMBERS:

Commitment:

- signed contract of commitment (12 months minimum);
- regular and punctual payment of fees;
- regular and punctual attendance at band rehearsals/performances;
- regular and punctual attendance at tutorials (after school);
- regular home practice minimum of 60 minutes per week for Training Band;
- co-operation being a <u>team</u> member;
- remembering that while band is a privilege and a serious undertaking, class work remains a priority;
- should a band member fail to comply with the conditions of the signed contract then his/her position in the band will be reviewed.

Instrument Care:

- signed musical instrument loan agreement;
- responsibility for care and cleaning during the year.

Organisation of Equipment:

- instrument;
- necessary instrument equipment e.g., reeds, oil etc.
- tutor book **Essential Elements** Book 1.
- access to the internet (this can be through an iPad) to utilise the full features of the <u>Essential</u> <u>Elements</u> program;
- A4 display book, band and practice folder which stores sheet music and practice pages.

PARENTS: PLEASE NOTE BEFORE CONSIDERING PURCHASING PRIVATELY

Parents are advised that should the private purchase of an instrument be considered that they await advice on instrument suitability, student's aptitude and interest prior to making a purchase. Consultation with our Band Director would also be required to ensure that this instrument, newly purchased, would contribute to the overall balance of the band's instrumentation. The local music stores and internet shops, while often offering reputable brands, also generally have several much lower quality, cheaper instrument brands available. These instruments are usually more difficult to play and easily broken leading to expensive repair costs. With musical instruments you usually get what you pay for. If you purchase a second-hand instrument please ensure that it has been fully serviced by a reputable repairer to give your child the best opportunity for a great start in band.

FEES: The band program is a voluntary extra-curricular activity. It is **essential** that you pay fees if you would like your child to participate in the program.

This is the fee structure for 2021:

CPS BAND FEES

Band Tutor Book \$20 (for the year)
Sturdy foldable Music Stand (required for home practice) \$40 – one off purchase (if required)
Band Fee \$280 (per semester)
Band Shirt \$20

Please note:

- Band fees are calculated on a YEARLY basis but are payable in 2 semester instalments.
- Unfortunately due to this being an extra curricular activity, there is no student financial assistance available for the band program.
- Invoices will be posted home each term and prompt payment is *essential*.

A NOTE TO CONCLUDE

Our school has been extremely proud of the development of its bands over the past few years. Band members in 2021 will continue to gain skills which reach far beyond the boundaries of music to enhance learning across the curriculum and which will serve the students for many years into the future.
