# Whole Numbers

- Counting forwards to 30
- Counting backwards from 20
- Stating the number before and after a given number
- One to one correspondence when counting
- Recognising dot patterns on dice and dominoes Addition and Subtraction
- Combine two or more groups of objects to model addition
- Model subtraction by separating and taking away part of a group of objects
- Use concrete materials or fingers to model and solve simple addition and subtraction problems

# Patterns

 Recognises, describes and continues repeating patterns

### <u>3D Space</u>

 Manipulates, sorts and represents threedimensional objects and describes them using everyday language

### Data

- Organise data into simple data displays
- Interpret data

### Mass

- Use everyday language to describe objects in terms of their mass
- Use comparative language to describe mass
- Compare two masses directly by hefting
- Record comparisons of mass informally using drawings, numerals and words
